7. System Service Standards

Asher gave a presentation on Title VI Service Standards and Policies. Title VI Service Standards and Policies are unique to each transit agency that allow it to measure performance and serve as a guide for making service decisions. Service standard indicators include vehicle load, vehicle headway, on-time performance, and service availability. Service Policies include the distribution of amenities and vehicle assignments.

8. Manager's Report

Ridership for August increased six percent over 2013. Nearly 10,000 more riders than last year.

Staff is currently working on the Longview Budget and will soon begin working on the Cowlitz Transit Authority budget. Staff will have a draft budget for the Board to review at the October meeting.

Staff will be working the a new No Show Policy for our Paratransit plan. The current No Show Policy was found insufficient by the Triennial Review.
